AFCT - This exam is given only to military personnel and requires a DA Form 4187 signed by the Commander for approval prior to testing.*

SIFT - This exam is given only to military personnel and requires a DA Form 4187 signed by the Commander prior to testing. Soldiers must obtain a score of 40 to meet the minimum requirement.*

DLPT - This exam is given only to military personnel and requires a DA Form 4187 signed by the Commander for approval prior to testing. Soldiers must wait 180 days before a retest is permitted.*

DLAB - This exam is given only to military personnel and requires a DA Form 4187 signed by the Commander for approval prior to testing. Soldiers must obtain a score of 95 or higher to pass (effective 01 Oct 06).*

GT Predictor Test - This exam tests the three components of the AFCT that determine the GT score (arithmetic reasoning, work knowledge, paragraph comprehension). No DA Form 4187 is required. Soldiers must schedule an appointment prior to testing.

TABE - Test of Adult Basic Education. This test is a requirement for BSEP and for admittance into certain Army schools. No DA Form 4187 is required. Soldiers must schedule an appointment prior to testing.

ACT - This exam is only available to military personnel at this facility. Use of a regular or scientific calculator is permitted. <http://www.act.org>

SAT - This exam is only available to military personnel at this facility. Use of a regular or scientific calculator is permitted. Retest participants must pay the current test fees prior to retesting. <http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/sat/codelist.html>

GRE - This exam is given at National Test Centers. <http://www.ets.org> **

GMAT - This exam is given at National Testing Centers. <http://www.mba.com/mba> **

* Soldiers taking military tests must be in military uniform, arrive on time, and have CAC card with them.

** Military personnel may apply for reimbursement (first exam only) for GRE or GMAT within 90 days of test. Must bring score report and show military ID to education center personnel in order to receive the reimbursement form.
