An estimated 58,000 Americans gave their lives in service to their country during the Vietnam War. For the ones they left behind at home, touching a name on "the Wall," a Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C., can be a tactile way to remember those lost. A nonprofit organization called the American Veterans Traveling Tribute created a replica of the Wall to share around the country.
